Harford County to Honor 100th Anniversary of Armistice Day on November 11

BEL AIR, Md., (Oct. 30, 2018) - At 11 a.m. on Sunday, November 11, Harford County Executive Barry Glassman will lay a wreath at the World War I memorial at Tydings Park in Havre de Grace, joining Mayor Bill Martin and other local officials in remembrance of the 100th anniversary of Armistice Day, organized by the Joseph L. Davis American Legion Post 47.

Encouraging all Harford County citizens to join in a moment of silence, County Executive Glassman today issued the following statement:

"From the American Revolution to the present, Harford County citizens have answered the call to defend our nation, and World War I was no exception.
